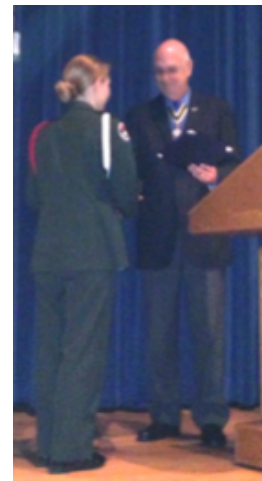
The Memorial Day Celebration at Culpeper National Cemetery was attended by President Bill Schwetke and Past-President Jerry Hubbard.
